



Our School Uniform - EYFS



The school has a smart and distinctive uniform which all children are expected to wear. Parents are asked to support the school in maintaining a high standard of appearance.

Nursery

All children

White polo shirt

Red sweatshirt

Red jogging bottoms

Black pumps indoors / trainers outdoors

Reception

Girls

White polo shirt

Grey skirt or pinafore dress

Red cardigan

Black shoes (Velcro)

Grey socks or tights

Simple red gingham dress (summer term only)

Red or black hair accessories

Boys

White polo shirt

Grey trousers (autumn term)

Red V-neck jumper

Black shoes (Velcro)

Grey socks

Grey shorts (summer term)

P.E. KIT

Reception-Year 6

Our P.E. Kit is the same for both boys and girls and consists of the following:

Red T shirt

Black shorts

Black pumps (indoors) / Velcro trainers (outdoors)

These should also be marked with the child's name and kept in a small draw-string bag.

Children are also allowed plain black jogging bottoms and a plain black zipped jacket for outdoor games if desired.

Jewellery

No jewellery should be worn in school, except for a wristwatch from Year 2 upwards (no smart watches), which must be removed before any physical education activity.

No earrings – we ask if you wish to get your child's ears pierced, you do so at the start of the summer holidays so they can be removed in September for school.

Hair

Boys and girls with hair reaching shoulder length must tie it back with a band in school colours (red or black). If your child attends school with their hair loose they will be given an elastic band to tie hair up with. Any hair accessory worn by your child should be discrete and either red or black. Hairstyles which are deemed to be extreme are not permitted e.g. lines or patterns shaven into the hair.

Footwear

Children should also wear sensible black footwear – no fashion shoes and no high heels. Velcro shoes are recommended for children in the Early Years (Nursery and Reception), including Velcro trainers for P.E. Children should only wear laces if they are able to tie them themselves.

All items of clothing must be clearly marked with the child's name.
