NEW SIGNING IN IF CHILDREN ARE LATE

To be GDPR compliant, and in line with all other schools, we now have an electronic sign in system for all our staff and visitors. This system is also used for parents or grandparents to sign children into school if they arrive late. It's a very quick and easy system to use and takes less than 30 seconds to complete for your child if you are late.

Just select the 'Pupil In/Out' button on the right had side of the screen.

The information needed is simple.

- Type your child's name
- Parents name...e.g. dad, nan, etc.
- Type year group...e.g. 6 or R
- Reason...

This system links with our SIMS system so it ensures our records are up-to-date and children are appropriately registered. Thank you.



On **Wednesday 4th December** (next week!) the school kitchen will be serving their Christmas dinner to **all those children who are on hot dinners**.


Those children who are on packed lunches can bring in a festive Christmas packed lunch on Wednesday. This can include a few Christmas treats.
